Sixty six pounds Eighteen shillings and Two pence half penny
Composition of which Two hundred and fifty pounds is due to
the Rev. Sir Thomas Foster Bart. Rector of said parish and
his Successors and Sixteen pounds Eighteen shillings and two
pence half penny is due to Charles Cooper as Lessee from the
Impropriator of the half Corn tithes of Ballyarthur and
Kilmagis

And that we do also Consent on Behalf
of the Owners and Occupiers of said parish That the
Composition Above named be Invariable for the Term of
Twenty one Years from the first day of November One thousand
Eight hundred and Twenty four
