

*A Duplicate of Tithe Composition Certificate for the parish of Killahurley
in the County of Wicklow and Diocese of Dublin*

*We William Coates and William Stacks Commissioners duly appointed
and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the 4th year of the
reign of King George the 4th entitled an act to provide for the establishing
of composition for tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and fix a
true and just composition for all tithes, arising, growing, yielded, or payable
within the parish of Killahurley in the County of Wicklow and diocese of Dublin
Do hereby certify that the true and just amount of composition for all
tithes whatsoever within the said parish is Eighty three pounds one Shilling
and six pence halfpenny British Currency by the year of which sum two
thirds or fifty five pounds seven shillings and eight pence farthings
are due and payable to the Honourable and Right Reverend Charles
Lindsey Lord Bishop of Kildare and dean of Christ Church as a com-
position for the tithes claimable by him as Rector of the said parish
and one third or twenty seven pounds fifteen shillings and ten pence farthings
sterling are due and payable to Henry Brownrigg^{as} Vicar of Killahurley
parish as a composition for the tithes claimable by him out of said parish
And we do further certify that the average price of oats being the corn principal-
ly grown in the parish of Killahurley for the period of seven years ending the
first day of November 1821 is thirteen shillings and eleven pence halfpenny
