

I Anketell Seton Commissioner duly appointed and
Sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the second and
third years of the reign of His Majesty King William the
Fourth intituled an Act to amend several Acts passed res-
pectively in the fourth, fifth and seventh and eighth years
of the reign of His late Majesty King George the Fourth
providing for the settling of compositions for tithes in
Ireland and to make such compositions permanent) do
ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all
tithes arising, growing, yielded and payable within the Parish
of Keshmole in the County of Wicklow. do hereby certify that
the true and just amount of composition for all tithes, whatev-
er within the said Parish is the Hundred and Twenty pounds
by the year of which sum of the Hundred and Twenty
pounds Sixty pounds are due and payable to the Part of
Tithes claimable as a composition for the third part of the Corn
tithes claimable by him as being impropriate in said Parish
and Sixty pounds are due and payable to the Rev Thomas
Percival Magee as a composition for the third part of
the Corn tithes and the Hay tithes claimable by him (as
Rector of the Union of Wicklow) in said Parish viz Thirty
pounds for the third part of the Corn tithes and Thirty
pounds for the Hay tithes. And I do further certify that
the average price of wheat and oats being the Corn price
respectively given in said County for seven years ending November
the first 1830 is for wheat 1.12.0% and for Oats 12.11% p Barriell
I do further certify that an agreement was entered into between the
tithes owners and the Land holders of said Parish for the sum
